## NEW TERMINAL 3 AT GRU AIRPORT INCREASES CAPACITY TO RECEIVE PASSENGERS, AIRCRAFTS AND CARGO

The Passenger Terminal 3 (TPS3) at GRU Airport began operations on May 11th, with the capacity to receive 12 million passengers per year in this first phase. Dedicated to international flights, the new terminal is comprised of 192,000 m<sup>2</sup> and is fitted with technology and equipment comparable to the best airports in the world.

The restricted area in the new facility is larger than the lounge area, following the model of the main Asian and European airports. The objective is to have passengers complete all pre-boarding procedures, such as: check-in, baggage check, security inspection and passport control, and then comfortably wait for their flights at the restricted area.

The apron has also been expanded, providing more aircraft stands and reducing waiting time. The new facility was also designed to receive larger (Code F) aircrafts. Currently, we have a Boeing 747-8 operating in the new terminal, flying the GRU-Frankfurt route. This means increased passenger and cargo capacity, including from air freighters.

With the new terminal and the two aprons, the airport increased the number of stands from 61 to 108. Starting at the second semester of the year, GRU Airport will be capable to receive cargo air freighters at any schedule, thus decreasing cargo unload times and making the clearance procedures faster.

## GRU AIRPORT RECEIVE AIR FREIGHT CHARTER

In the early hours of May 22nd a chartered freighter landed at GRU Airport. Flight LH 8262 coming from Madrid, with 22 tons of cargo - 10 tons of pharmaceutical goods and 12 tons of automobile and electronic goods.

DHL Global Forwarding was responsible for negotiating the freighter with Lufthansa Cargo in order to meet an specific demand of a pharmaceutical industry. Being able to consolidate 100 pallets into a single flight, with the assurance of an efficient unloading and acceptance process and of cold storage at GRU Airport Cargo facilities was beneficial for the customer.

This operation represents the first step in a process to increase the number of air freighters to GRU Airport Cargo. The cargo commercial department works to service new partners, bring new flights and to supply the demands of the logistics industry. After this trial operation, other flights are expected to start operating regularly in Guarulhos. Today, GRU Cargo already receives cargo aircrafts from ABSA, which weekly operates the international Miami-Guarulhos route, and the domestic Manaus-Guarulhos route daily.

According Cristina Bishop, Director of d DHL Global Forwarding's Produto Aéreo, since the beginning of negotiations in January of this year, GRU Airport demonstrated is was capable and ready to manage the operation. "This support gave us the needed confidence to move ahead with this important operation, which was flawlessly executed on May, 22nd. Dedication by all parties: DHL, Lufthansa Cargo and GRU Airport was essential to the success of this chartering," Cristina highlights.

#### COLD STORAGE FOR CARGO EXPORTS

The cold storage facility in the exports warehouse is fully functional, receiving different types of products that need to be kept under controlled temperatures.

During the first two months of operations more than 100 tons of cargo has been stored, assuring higher quality to exported products.
